The original six 3-digit industries included: Specialty trade contractors; Food manufacturing; Building material and garden equipment supplies dealers; Air transportation; Warehousing and storage; and Nursing and residential care facilities.

<sup>5</sup> Information is not shown separately for injured workers under age 14; they accounted for less than or equal to 50 cases.

<sup>6</sup> Race and ethnicity data do not add to total. Some cases may be counted as both multi-race and Hispanic and other race.
