

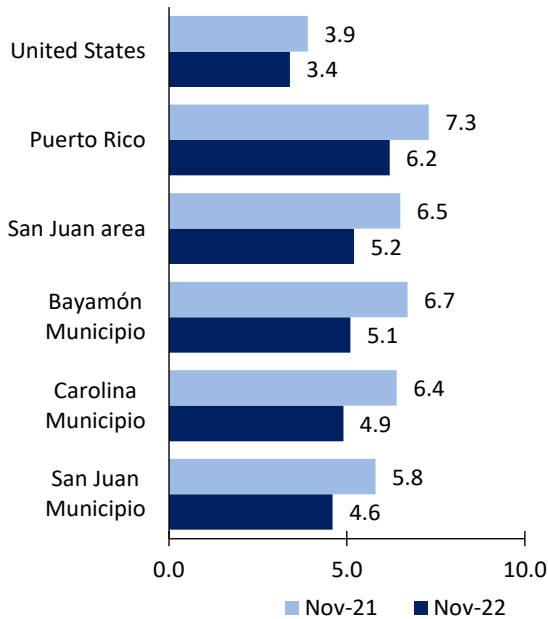
San Juan Area Economic Summary

Unemployment rates

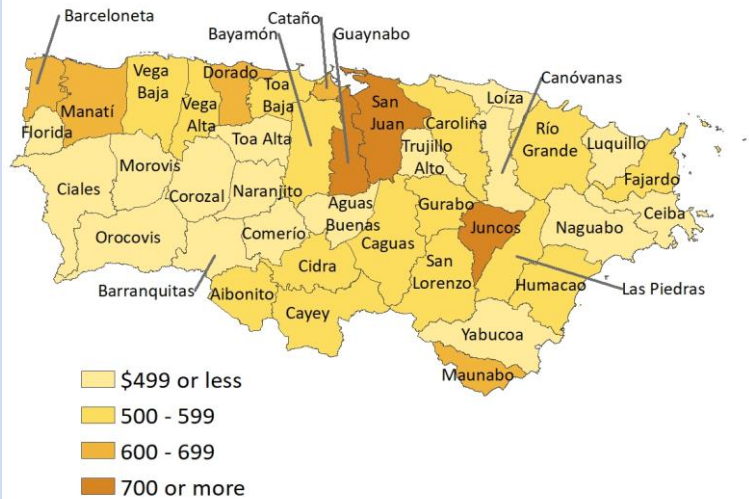

San Juan area, second quarter 2022

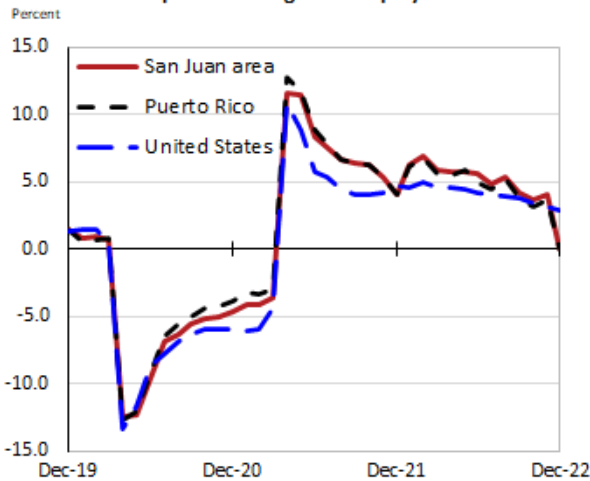
